



Urgent needs for the Municipality of Gaza in the wake of the Israeli aggression on Gaza Strip

Current Situation

In light of the **ongoing Israeli aggression on the Gaza Strip**, **Israeli military airstrikes** have targeted and devastated the city infrastructure networks, **streets and water, wastewater and electricity networks**. The infrastructure in Gaza City was subjected to destruction and damage as a result of the barbaric Israeli aggression on the Gaza Strip, **which targeted the innocent civilian population, residential buildings, service stations and vital facilities**.

Since the first attack, the **municipal emergency-response teams** were dispatched to the field to **reopen** the devastated streets in front of the **ambulances, civil defense, rescue teams and other services vehicles**.

The catastrophic implications arising from the **complete shutdown of the Gaza Power Generation Plant** and the **depletion of fuel** necessary for the municipalities to continue providing essential services has **contributed to an acute water crisis** in the Gaza Strip, attributed to an **80% deficit in water** resources, in which **most of the water wells are non-operational** now, in addition to the **accumulation of solid household waste** in the streets and neighborhoods, and at waste collection sub-station in the city centers, which are not designed to keep waste for extended periods of time.

Therefore, the Municipality of Gaza is seeking to secure emergency funding to revive the lives of the people of Gaza.

Gaza City

Gaza is a Palestinian coastal city. It is one of the oldest cities in the world, with a population of more than 750,000 inhabitants in 2022 and an area of 55.7 square kilometers, which makes it one of the most-densely populated cities in the world (13,465 persons per square kilometer). Gaza is burdened by a burgeoning population and an ongoing blockade. This very limited densely-populated area makes it difficult to find space for new schools or even graveyards, let alone green or agricultural areas.

The Municipality of Gaza (MoG)

MoG was established in 1893. It serves more than 1.2 million citizens, refugees and visitors, who commute to the city from other places. MoG provides the basic services, which include, but not limited to, Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH), environmental, social, economic and cultural services. It is the largest municipality in Palestine. Gaza City hosts most of the government offices, local and international institutions, public and private hospitals, various educational institutions and tourism and recreational areas.
